Our project

COP in MyCity is a youth-led project which ambitions to bridge the gap between climate negotiations (a.k.a. the COPs) and the mainstream public.

How? By fostering education and action about climate change locally and by creating an international community of changemakers.

Objectives

- Mobilizing the youth and increasing knowledge about climate change and international climate negotiations during the next Conferences of the Parties (COP): Lima for COP20 (2014) and Paris for COP21 (2015)
- Deepening the interconnections existing between international climate negotiations and local climate action
- Creating a strong international and intercultural community of young changemakers committed to the fight against climate change

Did you say "COP"?

The Conferences of the Parties (COPs) are annual international negotiations on climate change. They serve as a meeting of the 195 Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

The COPs aim to assess the progress made in reducing greenhouse gas emissions and to encourage further commitments, in accordance with countries' common but differentiated responsibilities and their respective capabilities.


Expectations are particularly high for COP21 which will take place in Paris in 2015, that is shortly before the deadline set in Durban to reach a global agreement. COP21 could therefore well result in the first universal agreement on climate in over 20 years of UN negotiations!

Training

Mobilization

Flashmobs, live video-meetings with the COP, collaborative workshops, launching of concrete projects for mitigation and adaptation to climate change

Empowerment

Skill-sharing, launching concrete projects for attenuation and adaptation to climate change

Debrief


